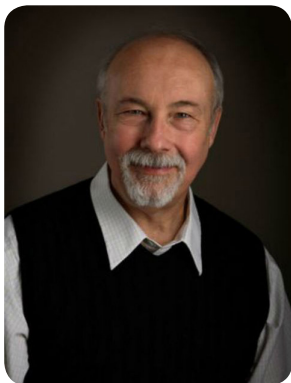
Living the Reading-Writing Connection

Keynote Speaker: Dr. Timothy Rasinski

Dr. Timothy Rasinski, professor of literacy at Kent State University, has written over 250 articles and has authored, coauthored or edited over 50 books or curriculum programs on reading education. He is author of the bestselling book on reading fluency entitled *The Fluent Reader*, and coauthor of the award-winning vocabulary program called *Building Vocabulary*.



His scholarly interests include reading fluency and word study, readers who struggle, and parental involvement. In 2010, he was elected to the International Reading Hall of Fame.
